NMLS-48498	Date columns sorting on TA License List Fix	A fix was made to the Temporary Authority (TA) License List correcting the Status Date and Application Date sort capability.	Regulator
NMLS-49293	Regulator TA License Dashboard and List	A fix was made to correct the TA Dashboard field for durations of "<60" days to include counts for licenses that became TA active on the current system date. The fix also allows the TA License List to correctly calculate Active TA Duration when an individual has had Temporary Authority for the same license type more than once.	Regulator
NMLS-50705	Confirm IDV on individual renewals workflow	As an effort to reduce errors associated with processing renewals carts, an enhancement was made to check an individual's Identity Verification (IDV) status prior to the individual requesting or attesting for renewal. An individual will not be allowed to submit or attest to a license that requires a credit report for renewals when their IDV status is unverified. As part of this enhancement, individuals who are unverified can verify their identity within the renewals process, when requesting or attesting for renewal.	Individual Company and Institution
NMLS-51008	Renewals Cart Processing Enhancements	An enhancement was made to the renewals cart functionality to help identify the root cause when a submission fails due to a failed credit request.	Individual and Company

NMLS-51549	CHRI and CBC Changes	<p>The following enhancements were made to maintain compliance with the FBI Privacy Act:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. When a CBC is requested, the relevant individual for the MU2, MU4, or MU4R filings will see the Privacy Act Statement displayed on the attestation page.2. The FBI Privacy Act Statement and the link to FBI Information on how to amend your record is displayed on the CBC Request page in Individual Composite.3. When a CBC is requested as a part of the renewal attestation, the relevant individual will be presented the Privacy Act Statement on the attestation page.4. Users are required to accept Notice of CHRI Data before viewing a CHRI status in the federal and state composite. The acceptance of the notice will be audited.
