## Instructions

The following amendments require instructions or items sent outside the NMLS:

- 1. Change of license status
- 2. Change of name
- 3. Change of contact information
- 4. File any Amendments in NMLS through the Filing Tab and through Form MU4.
  - For employment changes Log into your account on the Division website @ <u>https://eservices.psiexams.com/index\_login.jsp</u> and update company name, email, etc
    - Update the employment section of Form MU4 and submit
    - Confirm that the email address listed in the following locations is current in NMLS and RMS
    - Home Tab>My Account>Update User Profile
    - Filing Tab>Individual>Identifying Information
