



LOUISIANA MORTGAGE LOAN ORIGINATOR LICENSE

Instructions:

- 1. Request to surrender license must be submitted through the NMLS.
- 2. There is no fee to surrender a license.
- 3. Contact information must be updated on the NMLS, including current e-mail address and phone numbers.
- 4. Cancel your relationship with the company on the NMLS unless you are employed by the company in some capacity other than originator.
- 5. Update your employment history and E-Mail address
- 6. Send nothing to OFI pertaining to surrender of your license. We may request additional information upon review of your surrender; watch your e-mail for such requests.

NOTE: It is extremely important that each originator have their own e-mail address and that all e-mail addresses are current. Notifications of status changes and requests for information will only be sent to you from the NMLS. You are responsible for checking the status of your originator application on the NMLS and reading all e-mails generated by the NMLS and/or OFI.
