

## Surrender Checklist Jurisdiction-Specific Requirements



## LOUISIANA MORTGAGE BRANCH REGISTRATION

## Instructions:

- 1. File the branch location surrender request through the NMLS.
- 2. The company must either remove the sponsorship for the Louisiana licensed loan originators sponsored and assigned to this branch location through the NMLS (which will change their status to Approved-Inactive) or have the originator(s) change their employment address on their MU4 to reflect their new branch location.
- 3. Louisiana does not charge a fee to surrender a branch registration.
- 4. Louisiana does not require that any information be submitted outside the NMLS in order to surrender a branch location. However, we may request additional information upon review of your surrender; watch your e-mail for such requests.
