A branch office is defined as any location at which the business of a mortgage banker is to be conducted, including (a) any offices physically located in Nebraska, (b) any offices that, while not physically located in this state, intend to transact business with Nebraska residents, and (c) any third-party or home-based locations that agents and representatives intend to use to transact business with Nebraska residents.

This license should only be applied for by a company that also holds or is applying for a Nebraska Mortgage Banker license.
