# **NEVADA EXEMPT COMPANY REGISTRATION**

#### Instructions

When making changes to your record in NMLS, Nevada requires advance notification for some changes. See checklist below for details.

#### **Pre-Notification:**

If an exempt company changes its structure, name and/or ownership or affiliation, and such change results in a change in regulator and/or license, the holder of the Exemption Certificate must demonstrate that he or she continues to qualify for the exemption prior to amending the MU1 or MU2 form. The company must provide to the Division, outside of NMLS, a letter from the new entity or agency which will regulate the company supporting that the license of the company provides the right to make or broker mortgage loans and confirming that the entity or agency will investigate complaints arising from or relating to consumers in Nevada. The Division will notify the company directly once the submission has been approved and the company is authorized to make the changes in NMLS.

If the exempt company has a Nevada electronic bond deposited in NMLS and changes its name, prior to amending the name on the MU1, the company must obtain either a new electronic bond or rider to the bond amending the principal name.

Additionally, if a company changes its name, legal structure or officers, the company will need to amend its filings with the Nevada Secretary of State's Office, as well as possible changes to the local business license and Nevada State business license, if applicable.

A Certificate of Exemption expires automatically if at any time the entity who claims the exemption no longer meets the requirements of at least one exemption set forth in the provisions of NRS 645B.015. If a company ceases to qualify under law to be exempt from licensing due to a change in structure, ownership or affiliation, the company must obtain a mortgage company license, as applicable, prior to conducting mortgage activity.

### **Address Changes**

Ten days prior to amending its address in NMLS, an exempt company must make the requested changes in NMLS. The certificate will be reissued with the correct address and it will be emailed to the exempt company contact once the Division has approved the change. Additionally, an exempt company must ensure that any mortgage agents associated with the office amend the employment history section of their MU4 to reflect the correct employer address.

## **Change to Qualified Employee**

Changes in the qualified employee should be made in the NMLS system and required documentation uploaded to the "Additional Requirements" section.

All other amendments to the company record can be made through NMLS without prior notification or pre-approval. To amend forms in NMLS, enter the Filing Tab, the appropriate MU Form, create

a new filing and enter the section of the form that requires amendment, make the appropriate changes, proceed to the "complete and submit" field and attest to all changes. Change in Control Persons must be through amendments to applicable MU2 forms or by submission of new MU2's.
