



Filing Refresh

Overview/Policy

A refresh enables the user to update the un-submitted filing in the System with the latest information available.

There are several scenarios where the "*Refresh"* screen displays and a user may accept or reject changes. Below is a list of the most common:

- There is a new form version of the pending filing (Company, Branch or Individual MU forms) and a user can accept those changes and edit/submit a new form version.
- A License status was updated after an action request was entered on the filing or License status that was available on the filing is terminated.
- When a company's *Tax ID* is updated and that company is listed as a Direct or Indirect Owner on a pending Company (MU1) Form, the System allows the filing company to refresh the information and populate the filing with the updated Tax id.

There are two scenarios where the "Refresh" screen displays and the user must accept changes by clicking **Refresh**:

- *License/Employment* information has changed since the last refresh and the related action on the pending filing.
- One or more Advanced Change Notices were processed since the last refresh.


Refresh the Filing:

1. Click either **Accept Changes** or **Refresh** to update this filing with recent information.

NOTE: Depending on the scenarios listed above determines the user options listed on the *Refresh* screens below. The example is listed for the Company (MU1) Form, however the same *Refresh* screens exist for Individual (MU2 and MU4) and Branch (MU3) Forms.
